Student Role: Getting started with Scoir!

Scoir is a free platform that will help students stay connected with their counselor and prepare for the college search process! All high school students will have access to this platform. To begin and make the most out of Scoir, students will need to:

• Create an account at https: https://app.scoir.com/signup?hsid=101147

Through this platform students will be able to search for colleges based on academic/personal interests, build their college list, and keep all their application documents to be submitted in one place.

- Build a Profile. Students can add activities, achievements, and a personal bio and transfer this information over to their college application. Keep this information up to date so they can use the SCOIR resume template when needed!
- Explore, follow, and compare Colleges. Complete a Preference and Advanced Search. After they complete a search, they will be able to explore colleges of interest take advantage of the virtual tours, and college details to gain insight into each campus. They can compare up to 4 colleges side-by-side.
- Add Colleges to their Colleges List. Keep track of the colleges that interest them. They can access this list at any time and keep track of and review Counselor and Parent college suggestions.
- Learn about top aptitudes and suggested career paths. Learn about your top aptitudes and career paths through YouScience a career assessment
