- The SIP was presented via department meetings:
 - Align the school's Culture Outcome Statement, Essential Practice, and Priority Action.
 - Reviewed data map provided by the District.
 - School Culture
 - Teachers meet monthly to share Best Practices, via Departments.
 - Weekly collaboration for goal setting; will promote professional growth.
 - Primary Essential Practice
 - Teachers continue to attend Professional Development Workshops
 - Student Engagement: Monthly engaging activities created by Activities Director to promote school culture and school image.
 - Collaborative Data Chat: strategic planning to target specific standards; implementation of strategies and Best Practices shared at monthly department meetings.

- Priority Actions for Sustaining Essential Practices
 - Monthly meetings to share Best Practices; demonstrate leadership and professional growth; reward system to increase student participation and engagement in academic and extracurricular activities.
- Staff Survey: 92%
- Parent Survey: 81% (need to work on parent participation)
- Learning Gains: 66.425 (compared to District's 64%) Academic Outcomes is encouraging.
