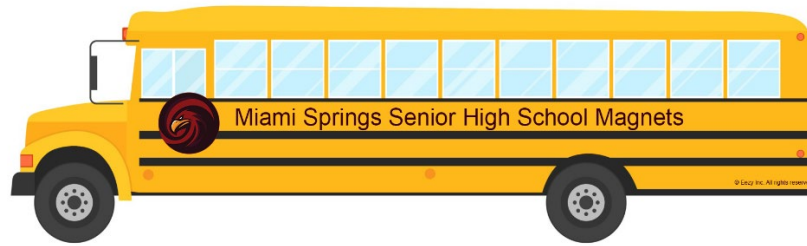


Magnet Transportation to Miami Springs Senior High School



Public School Bus Transportation Option

Transportation to our award-winning Magnet programs at Miami Springs Senior High School (SHS) depends on where you live and the transportation available for our school. If Miami Springs SHS is your child's neighborhood school, M-DCPS public school bus transportation is available through assigned locations and routes. Information on a student's bus assignment is posted on the M-DCPS Parent Portal. To access the information first go to <https://www3.dadeschools.net/parents> and then log on to the Parent Portal. The top of the Parent Portal screen has a link (click on BUS INFO) for the student's bus assignment information. Bus information is also available on the District's Mobile App that is available at no cost for both Apple and Android devices. Bus assignment information on the Parent Portal is updated every night. Parents are encouraged to periodically check the information on the Parent Portal so they will always have the most current information on their child's bus transportation. Parents who are not able to access the Parent Portal should call Miami Springs SHS at 305-885-3585 for assistance. Miami Springs SHS has access to the district's transportation routing system and should be able to answer most questions concerning a student's eligibility for transportation and bus assignment.

Miami-Dade County Transportation and Public Works K-12 Discount Program Option

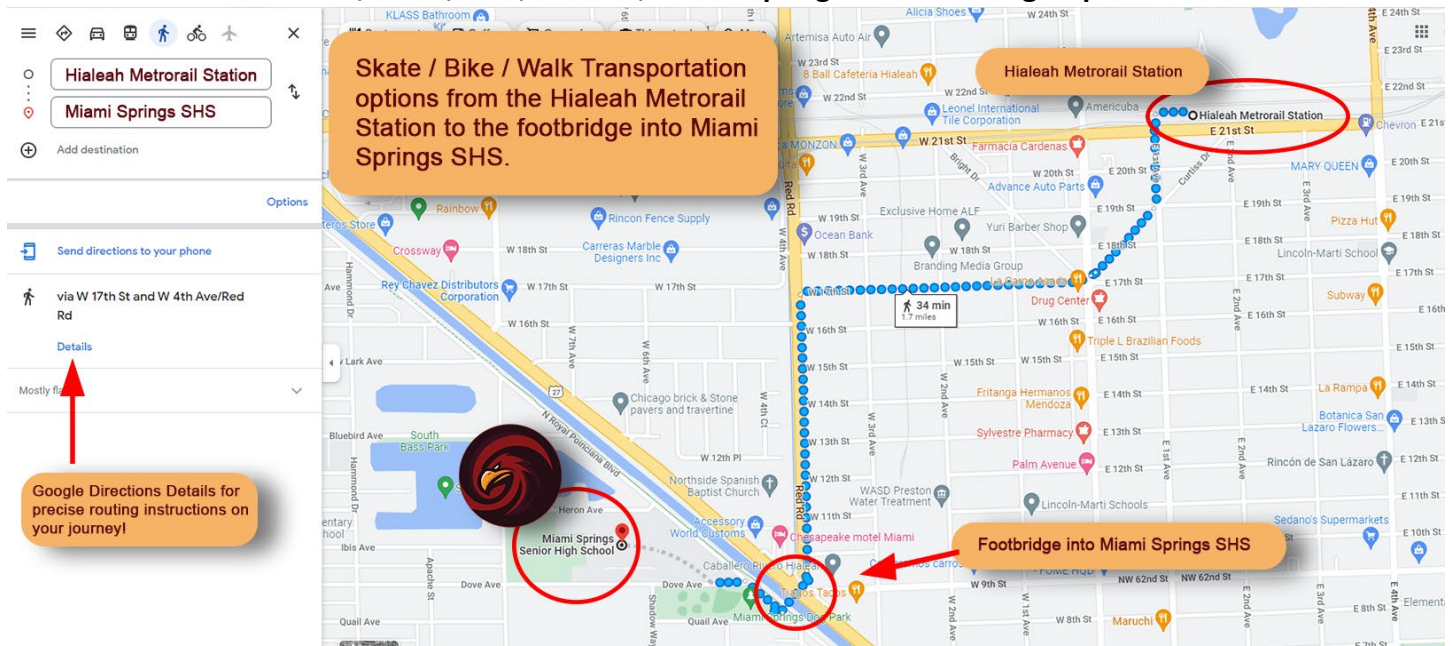
All students who attend public, charter or private schools in Miami-Dade County are eligible for a K-12 EASY Card. Students with a K-12 EASY Card can ride Metrobus and Metrorail for half price. Students must apply at www.miamidade.gov's K-12 Discount Program web site

Miami Springs SHS has a footbridge that safely connects students from Red Road and W 9 ST (NW 62 ST) to campus. Parents should begin by consulting www.miamidade.gov's Miami-Dade County Transit System Map Brochure to find their appropriate routes to the footbridge at Miami Springs SHS. Miami Springs Shuttle Bus Option



The City of Miami Springs provides this free community bus service to increase the number of local destinations that can be reached by public transit. The MS/VG Shuttle has designated bus stops and will also pick-up passengers who hail it along the enclosed route, except for NW 36 Street. There are 2 additional shuttle bus stops in Hialeah at the CVS on NW 54 Street/Hialeah Dr. & East 1st Ave and the Hialeah Metrorail Station on East 21 Street/NW 74 Street & East 1st Ave. The shuttle stops at Miami Springs SHS.
